

Lecturer Performance Based on Courses

The purpose of the measurement activities conducted by Universitas Airlangga is to (1) collect basic data on the performance of lecturers, institutions, and learning support subsystems, (2) enhance the quality of the learning process and services to students, (3) verify the successful implementation of established quality standards, and (4) provide input to policymakers to improve institutional performance for sustainable quality assurance. The measurement activities target various components involved in the learning process and services. The measurement activities take the form of filling out questionnaires containing a set of questions designed to measure the satisfaction level of respondents with the learning process and services. Response options on the questionnaire are presented in a score range from 1 to 4, indicating the level of satisfaction or performance index. Subsequently, the values are averaged for all respondents, resulting in the final satisfaction level on the following scale:

1.00 – < 1.75: dissatisfied/good

1.75 – < 2.50: less satisfied/good

2.50 – < 3.25: satisfied/good

3.25 – 4.00: very satisfied/good

Based on the above exposition, this report is compiled as a summary of the performance index of the BoS FISIP UNAIR study program in the implementation of education in the even semester of the academic year 2022-2023.
